Keep your furniture looking beautiful with proper care and maintenance.

- Avoid abrasive cleaning products —
When in doubt, use a mild soap and water solution.
- Never leave a wet cleaning substance on furniture to dry; it can damage the finish.
- Test cleaning product on inconspicuous area first—especially on solid wood and upholstery.
- Repair chipped powder coat and defaced wood surfaces with touch-up paints and stains from our factory.
- Product should be inspected and maintained regularly by tightening hardware and inspecting glides for damage. Any product with missing glides, hardware or other defects should be removed from service immediately.
- Turning seating upside down on the table voids the warranty

Indoor Surfaces

Solid Wood Table Top

Installation and Care Guidelines

Our solid wood table tops are designed and engineered to meet or exceed industry standards for flatness and stability. However, because solid wood is a living material, how it is stored, transported, and acclimated before and during installation plays a critical role in how it performs.

Wood naturally responds to the environment around it. Exposure to fluctuating temperatures, humidity, or improper storage — even for a short period — can cause movement that no amount of engineering can fully prevent. Caring for your table top before and after installation is just as important as how it’s built.

To get the best performance from your table, we recommend:

- Store the top flat, indoors, in a climate-controlled space prior to installation
- Allow table top it to acclimate in its intended environment for at least 48–72 hours before use
- Keep table top away from heat sources, exterior walls, and direct sunlight
- During installation, take care to not over-torque screws or fasteners, as this can stress and crack a solid wood top
- Once installed, maintain controlled indoor humidity levels year round

When these steps are followed, our table tops consistently perform beautifully for years.

Wood

Wipe surface with a mild soap or liquid dish washing detergent and warm water solution. Wipe dry with clean, soft cloth. Always leave furniture dry.

Tip: Avoid using any citrus-based products on wood chairs and tables — the citrus acts as a stain or finish stripper on wood products.

Metal

Wipe surface with a mild soap or liquid dish washing detergent and warm water solution. Disinfect the surface with a non-abrasive household cleaner like Formula 409®, Fantastik®, Windex®, or diluted SimpleGreen®. Wipe dry with clean, soft cloth.

Tip: Never let cleaning or disinfecting products dry onto the furniture surface. This can weaken and damage the epoxy finish leading to chips and scratches.

Laminate

Clean surface with a mild soap or liquid dish washing detergent and warm water solution. Disinfect the surface with a non-abrasive household cleaner — more information below. Wipe dry with clean, soft cloth.

- **Wilsonart:** Windex®, Glass Plus®, Fantastik®, Mr. Clean®, Formula 409®, Purell® Multi-Surface, Isopropyl Alcohol. [See Wilsonart’s complete cleaning and care guide for laminates.](#)
- **Other laminates:** A non-abrasive household cleaner like Formula 409®, Fantastik®, Windex®, or diluted SimpleGreen®.

Tip: Laminate is a hardy product, so for stubborn stains, a soft bristle brush with light scrubbing is acceptable.w

Table Edges (Wood, Vinyl, and Urethane)

Wipe surface with a mild soap or liquid dish washing detergent and warm water solution. Wipe dry with clean, soft cloth.

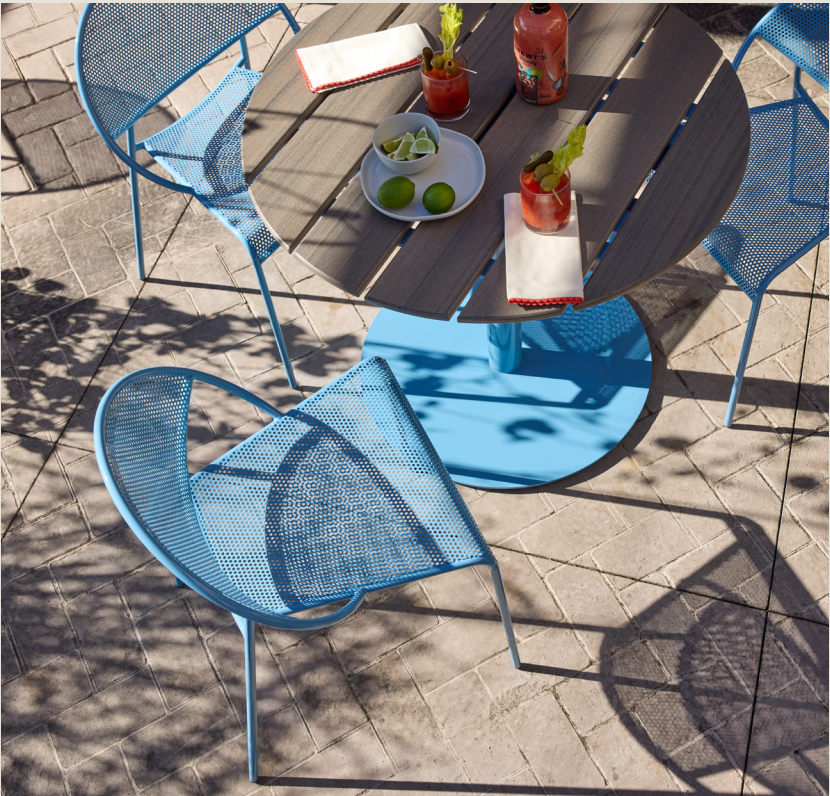
Tip: These three edges are vastly different in material and properties. To ensure minimal damage, opt for mild, soapy water.

Corian Tops

Use soapy water, ammonia-based cleaner (not window cleaner), rinse and wipe completely dry. Commercially available solid surface cleaners, such as Clean EnCounters® will also work well. [See Corian’s complete solid surface care and maintenance documentation.](#)

Upholstery

Not all textiles are created equal — certain materials will require different cleaning techniques and products. Please refer to the fabric manufacturers’ cleaning instructions for more information.



Outdoor Surfaces

HDPE

Clean surface with a mild soap and warm water solution.

Metal

Wipe with mild soap or liquid dish detergent and warm water solution. Disinfect surface with non-abrasive household cleaner like Formula 409®, Fantastik®, Windex®, or diluted SimpleGreen®. Wipe dry with clean, soft cloth.

If products are near a marine environment / swimming pool, regular cleaning with biodegradable liquid soap and water will help protect furniture from rapid deterioration that chlorine and salt may cause. Maintenance is recommended every 3 months. Never use a pressure/power washer on outdoor furniture.

Outdoor powdercoated product will require periodic finish inspection and maintenance. Inspect for scratches, chips or abrasions as steel may develop small rust spots over time where damage has occurred. Contact GRC for touch-up paint and procedure.
