

Did you know...

The color of wood changes naturally over time.

Wood is an organic material and its color naturally changes over time from exposure to light. Applying a finish slows down the color change. The change in color is most noticeable with a Natural finish.

This is important in the specification process and when reviewing material samples. Brand new finish or product samples will appear different than those that have naturally aged over time. — always check sample release dates for insight into color stage.



Beech
Starts as a pale, creamy color and deepens to a richer golden hue.

Maple
Starts as a creamy white and over time develops to a darker honey-golden color.

Hickory
Darkens to a richer, medium brown and its grain becomes more defined.

White Oak
Experiences minimal color shifts, with its golden tones growing slightly richer.

Walnut
Starts out as a dark brown and it gets lighter over time with rich honey undertones.
